

- Resignation: Walter Arabasz (after this meeting)
- Pending appointment term expirations: Jon Bray, Jim Harris



Program Developments

- Reauthorization not enacted in 111th Congress (more in later presentation)
- Agencies continuing their partnership and activities, within 2011 Continuing Resolution budget constraints (more later from agencies)
- Awaiting final Congressional budgeting decision for 2011 and reauthorization
- "Abbreviated" annual report on 2009 activities released in October 2010
- Preparation of 2010 annual report well underway
- USGS actively coordinating NEHRP communications following Christchurch, NZ, earthquake

- 3. NIST budget supports both NEHRP Secretariat and NIST Earthquake Risk Mitigation R&D Program. The FY 2012 request for NIST includes an increase of \$1.8M for Disaster and Failure Studies Program that is not included in funds reported for NEHRP.

Secretariat Activities (1/2)

 NEHRP Deputy Director (Dr. Steve McCabe) to start at NIST on 4/11/11 supports ACEHR recommendation

 Tina Faecke reassigned to focus on administrative duties that are related to all statutory programs in NIST Engineering Laboratory (EL) – includes work on NWIRP and DFSP, in addition to NEHRP

 Completion of ongoing National Research Council (NRC) effort to develop 20yr U.S. earthquake implementation roadmap delayed until 3/31/2011

 Plans for Interagency Coordinating Committee (ICC) meeting being made for 4/27/11 – ACEHR Chairman invited to meet with ICC



Secretariat Activities (2/2)

 Re-engaging Interagency Committee on Seismic Safety in Construction (ICSSC) in activity to update ICSSC RP-6, *Standards of Seismic Safety for Existing Federally Owned or Leased Buildings* (contract via Building Seismic Safety Council, BSSC) – kickoff meeting conducted at BSSC on 1/13/11

 Refocusing/re-engaging U.S. Japan Cooperative Program in Natural Resources Panel on Wind and Seismic Effects – meeting conducted in San Francisco on 2/3-4/11

Providing limited assistance to DoD as it updates its seismic design criteria

 Addition of Disaster and Failure Studies Program Director (Eric Letvin) in NIST Engineering Laboratory (full presentation to ACEHR planned during current meeting)
